ohnís Trailer Park was regarded as the most blighted property in Morgan Hill. Slum-like conditions throughout the 2.9-acre site lead to serious health and law-enforcement problems. A non-profit affordable housing developer, South County Housing, and the Morgan Hill Redevelopment Agency hired Weston Miles Architects to create a new, safe and attractive affordable housing community for very low-income residents. Fourteen single-wide, dilapidated trailers, two houses and two duplexes were replaced by 34 new residential units that reflect the nearby single-family homes. In all, Villa Ciolino provides 42 one-, two- and three-bedroom units for existing and new residents.
